Man charged with dangerous driving after pedestrian's death

The Ekiti State Police Command has arraigned a 24-year-old man, Jamie Sulaiman, before a magistrates' court sitting in Ado-Ekiti over allegations of dangerous driving that led to the death of one Oluwakoremide Ibukunola.

The prosecutor, Inspector Akinwale Oriyomi, told the court that on December 2, 2025, the defendant was operating a white TVS Neo motorcycle (Registration No: Ekiti ADK 468-QD) in front of the Ilawe Motor Park in the Adere area of Ado-Ekiti.

According to the charge sheet:

"The defendant did negligently ride the motorcycle on the highway in a dangerous manner, without regard for the circumstances, nature, condition or volume of traffic and dangerously knocked down and caused the death of 40-year-old Oluwakoremide Ibukunola."

Inspector Oriyomi noted that the defendant was operating the motorcycle on a public highway without a valid driver's licence.
