

2 Students Crushed To Death While Returning From School

Two students of the Government Secondary School (GSS) near the Salan filling station in Yangoji, Kwali Area Council of the FCT, have been crushed to death.

A witness said the incident happened on Tuesday around 2:54 pm when a Toyota Lexus Jeep with registration number PJHR 943, traveling at high speed, suddenly ran into the two students who were on their way home after school dismissal.

The witness stated that the driver lost control of the vehicle and rammed into the students, whose identities have yet to be confirmed.

Two other students also sustained injuries in the incident.

An official of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), who spoke on condition of anonymity, confirmed the accident. He stated that the driver veered off the road while speeding and struck the students as they were trekking home.

The official attributed the accident to a speed limit violation and fatigue. Investigations revealed that the driver, who was traveling from Jos, Plateau State, to Ondo State, failed to stop for a rest, which led to exhaustion.

He confirmed that the bodies of the two deceased students were handed over to their relatives for burial, while the two injured students were taken to Kwali General Hospital for treatment.

The FRSC official added that the driver and the vehicle have been handed over to the Kwali Police Division for further investigation.
