Kano fire service retrieves body of three-year-old from well

THE Kano State Fire Service has recovered the body of a three-year-old boy, Abdura'uf Badamasi, who was reported missing in Wangara Village, Tofa Local Council of Kano State.

The Director of the service, Sani Anas, disclosed this in a statement signed by the agency's Public Relations Officer, Saminu Abdullahi, and released at the weekend in Kano.

He said: "We received a distress call from one Dan Asabe Rabi'u on Friday

morning at about 7:50 a.m., reporting the disappearance of Badamasi.

"Upon receiving the report, a rescue team from the agency's headquarters was immediately deployed to the scene. On arrival, it was gathered that Badamasi had been missing since Thursday evening, with his parents suspecting that he might have fallen into a well."

Anas said firefighters promptly entered the well and rescued the child unconscious, but he was later confirmed dead.
