

“During the attack, three people lost their lives, while one other sustained injuries and was immediately rushed to a hospital for medical attention.

“In a follow-up clearance operation, a suspect, identified as Suleiman (male), was arrested around the Redemption Camp. The suspect was apprehended with visible blood stains and is currently in custody,” Alabo stated.

The Commissioner of Police, Plateau State Command, Bassey Ewah, visited the scene of the incident for an on-the-spot assessment of the situation.

He expressed condolences to the families of the deceased and assured them that a thorough investigation would be conducted to bring the fleeing suspects to justice.

He urged all Plateau residents to remain calm, vigilant, and report any suspicious activities to the nearest security agency.

However, to restore public confidence and prevent further threats on the community, the [Inspector General of Police \(IGP\), Olatunji Rilwan Disu](#), has reinforced security presence in the area through additional deployment, intensified patrols and synergy with other security agencies.

The CP emphasised the commitment of the Plateau State Police Command to safeguarding lives and property across the state.

He urged all residents to respect the curfew restrictions to avoid sanctions.
