

Seven Killed, 60 Injured in Ogun, Kano Road Crashes

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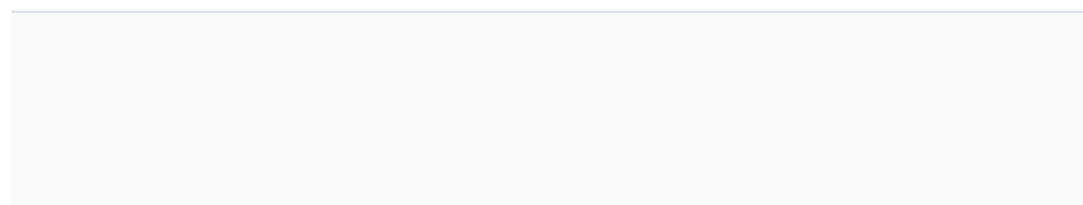
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Fatal crash at the Onipepeye axis along the Sagamu–Siun–Abeokuta Expressway,



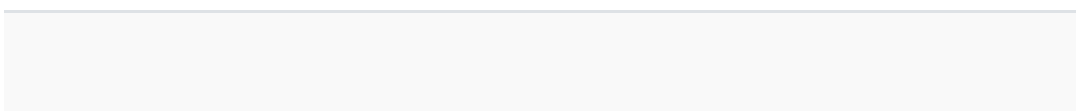
At least seven people have lost their lives, while 60 others sustained injuries in separate road accidents recorded in [Ogun State](#) and Kano State.

In Ogun State, a [fatal crash](#) occurred on Saturday at the Onipepeye axis along the [Sagamu–Siun–Abeokuta Expressway](#), claiming three lives and leaving seven others injured.

The [Federal Road Safety Corps](#) (FRSC) attributed the accident to excessive speeding and loss of vehicle control.

The crash reportedly involved a branded bus and a truck marked with “OGSG,” believed to be linked to the state government.

According to the Ogun State FRSC spokesperson, Afolabi Odunsi-Oyewole, the victims were taken to the State Hospital, Ijaye, Abeokuta, where the injured are receiving treatment, while the deceased have been deposited in the morgue.



Providing further details, the Ogun Sector Commander, Oludare Ogunjobi, confirmed that the accident occurred around 5:40 p.m. on April 18, 2026, involving a Sino truck and an Opel passenger vehicle.

FRSC emergency responders reported a total of 10 individuals were involved in the crash, including adults and children. Seven sustained varying degrees of injuries, while three fatalities were recorded.
