

Lakurawa Kills 10 In Kebbi Attack

No fewer than 10 herders were reportedly killed in a reprisal attack at a Fulani settlement in Tilli community of Bunza Local Government Area of Kebbi State on Sunday.

An indigene of the area who craved anonymity revealed this to LEADERSHIP Correspondent in Birnin Kebbi. He said that, the reprisal attack was carried out in the area following the killing of a vigilante member by the Lakurawa bandits.

He added that, the killing of the vigilante was blamed on the Fulani residing in the area and over 10 of them were killed and several sustain injuries during a raid carried out in their settlement by some suspected members of the community.

He said, “The reprisal attack was carried out in an error. They thought the Fulani were behind the killing of the vigilante man.

“They attacked them in their settlement. Over 10 of them were killed while several sustain injuries. They are still searching for more people who might have been killed in the attack”, he said.

According to the source, the State leadership of the Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association and the Deputy Governor of Kebbi State, Senator Umar Tafida were in the area to condole with families of those killed during the attack.
