

7 Die In Adamawa Road Crashes

Multiple accidents along two major roads have claimed seven lives in Adamawa state.

Five persons were said to have died along Song-Girei Road in Song local government area of the state.

According to an eyewitness, Salihu Manu, the incident involved a starlet Toyota car with registration number 969 AG and a Civilian Coaster bus with registration PV 123 AD, which had a head-on collision at the popular Sigire bend due to overspeeding and wrongful negotiation of the bend.

An official of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) who pleaded anonymity also said the other accident occurred along Jada-Mayo Belwa Road in Mayo-Belwa LGA, involving a Toyota Corolla, which had a tyre burst and somersaulted into the bush, killing two persons.

Many were reported to have sustained various degrees of injury, including a baby boy and were currently receiving treatment at Song and Mayo-Belwa General Hospitals, respectively.
