

# 1 Die, 18 Injured In Adamawa Accident

An accident involving a Toyota Hummer Bus has resulted in the death of one person, with 18 others injured in Adamawa state.

The Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Numan, Assistant Corps Commander Idi Timothy, confirmed the incident to newsmen yesterday.

He said the bus with registration number BLD 471 XL was conveying 19 passengers, adding that the crash resulted in the death of one passenger, a citizen of the Republic of Cameroon.

He said 18 others who sustained various degrees of injuries were evacuated to the General Hospital, Numan for treatment.

According to the commander, the accident was due to overspeeding.

Timothy used the opportunity to caution motorists to strictly adhere to traffic rules and regulations to avoid preventable crashes that often lead to loss of lives and property.

He also disclosed that AbdulRazak Bilyaminu, identified as the victim's younger brother, confirmed the death of his brother in the tragic accident.

The FRSC reiterated its commitment to ensuring road safety and urged road users to exercise caution at all times.
