

Truck Crushes Skater To Death In Jos

A truck loaded with cement has crushed a teenage skater at Terminus Market, Jos North local government area of Plateau State.

LEADERSHIP Friday gathered that the incident occurred at 9:30 pm when the trailer was heading out of Jos.

According to an eyewitness, Musa Audu, the incident occurred when the teenager held on to the trailer but unfortunately, the tyre of the truck hit and crushed him to death.

The accident raised concern among sympathisers who trooped to the scene.

Audu said, “The accident happened around 9:30pm when people had left the market. Before the victim was crushed to death, he was holding onto the vehicle and moving with it, unfortunately, the tyre of the truck hit him and the truck ran over him, killing him instantly.”

When contacted, Nasiru Yahaya, chairman of a section of Terminus Market, confirmed the incident to our correspondent.

Hisbah Arrests 9 Suspects Over ‘Farewell To Satan’ Party In Kano By Hafsat Bello Bahara

The Kano State Hisbah Board has arrested six women and three men for allegedly organising a party tagged “Farewell to Satan” ahead of the Ramadan fasting period. The Deputy Commander-General of the Hisbah Board, Dr. Mujahid Aminuddeen, disclosed this to journalists in the state. Aminuddeen said the suspects organised a casual party over the weekend and invited some controversial musicians known for promoting immoral acts to perform at the event, which they claimed was meant to bid farewell to the devil or satan before the commencement of holy month of Ramadan fasting on February 18, 2026. He stated that the action contravened moral standards and existing laws in Kano State. The deputy commander-general added that the suspects would be charged to court upon the conclusion of investigations. He further called on members of the public to remain vigilant and report any activity that violates moral values or the law to the authorities.
