

# Vigilante Member Shoots Colleague Dead In Plateau

A member of the Hunters Vigilante Group allegedly shot a colleague dead yesterday following a minor disagreement during a patrol in Vom, Jos South local government area of Plateau State.

Jafar Umar was allegedly shot by his fellow member.

Both were part of the Hunters Vigilante, a community-based security outfit operating in the region.

Jos South area commander of the Nigerian Forest Security Service, Pam Gyang Pwajok, confirmed the incident in a phone conversation with journalists.

He said: “I heard something like that happened in Vom but I don’t have details of the incident yet.

I have asked my people to investigate the incident and get back to me .So, I’m still waiting for the report.”
