

Perpetrators Of Kwande Killings Will Face The Law — Gov. Alia

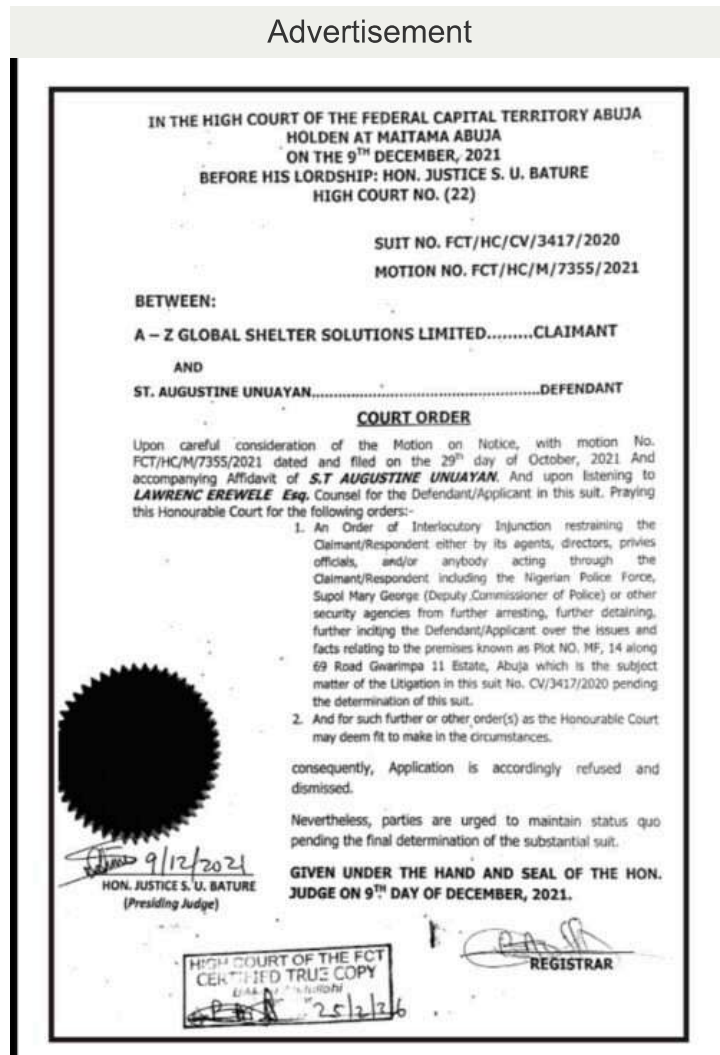

Governor of Benue State, Hyacinth Alia, has condemned the brutal killings in Tyungu Jam and Mbaav communities in Yaav and Mbadura Council wards of Kwande local government area which left 12 people dead and several others injured.

In a statement issued by his aide on media, publicity and strategic communication, Chief Solomon Iorpev yesterday, Governor Alia described the attack as “barbaric,

senseless and unacceptable.”

He expressed sorrow and outrage at the loss of lives and extended his condolences to families of the victims.



The governor who emphasised that every life matters and the loss of even one life is too many, assured the people of Kwande and Benue State that his administration would leave no stone unturned in ensuring that those responsible for the killings are held accountable.

He directed security agencies to intensify efforts to apprehend the perpetrators and prevent further attacks.

Alia assured residents that his administration was committed to ensuring the security and safety of all citizens and he will not be deterred by resistance from those opposed to peace.
