

Boko Haram Kills 1, Rustles 1,400 Sheep In Fresh Borno Attack

Suspected Boko Haram/ISWAP terrorists have killed one herder, injured another, and rustled 1,400 sheep in a nomadic settlement at Wuturo in Konduga local government area of Borno State.

A statement issued to journalists yesterday in Maiduguri by the police public relations officer Nahum Kenneth Daso, said the command condemned the recent attack on a nomadic settlement at Wuturo, Konduga local

government area, allegedly by suspected Boko Haram/ISWAP terrorists.

He said following a report received by Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association, Konduga at Konduga Police Division, that on 10th March, 2026 at about 2230hrs, unknown gunmen riding on five motorcycles invaded the settlement, preliminary investigations revealed that during the attack, one Ahmadu Baida, 40 years, sustained fatal gunshot injuries, while

Mohammadu Baida, 30years sustained a gunshot wound on his left leg.

Daso said the attackers also rustled about 1,400 sheep belonging to the herdsman.

He said that upon receipt of the report, a combined team of the Police, the Military, and other security stakeholders, including the Civilian Joint Task Force (CJTF) and local hunters, led by the Divisional Police Officer, Konduga, swiftly mobilised to the scene.
