

Scores Feared Dead As Bandits Invade Zamfara Community

Dangoro village in Nahuche ward, Bungudu Local Government Area, Zamfara State, has come under attack by Bandits.

The report indicated that the bandits raided the village, killing and injuring several people, including a 9-month pregnant woman.

It was gathered that several houses and grain stores were set

ablaze during the invasion.

A resident in the area who pleaded anonymity told Leadership on a telephone interview that the bandits raided the village at midnight on Sunday.

According to the Source, the bandits abducted an unspecified number of residents, mainly women, during the attack.

"As I am speaking now, we have yet to ascertain how many people were kidnapped, but the majority

of those who are kidnapped are mainly women". He said

According to him, the area is in a state of panic, with most residents fleeing to Nahuche town for safety following the attack.

He called on the Federal and Zamfara state governments to come to their rescue, noting that the bandits said they would come back for another attack.

When contacted for balancing, the Police Public Relations Officer, Zamfara State Command, DSP Yazid Abubakar, said, "I will get back to you, give me some minutes." Other calls to his line were unsuccessful.
