

Police Kill Bandit, Recover Rustled Cows In Kebbi

Kebbi State Police Command has said it killed one bandit and recovered 33 rustled cows along Kamba-Kangiwa Road in Dandi local government area of the state.

According to a statement by the command's spokesman, SP Bashir Usman, the success story was as a result of the efforts by the Joint operation with the Nigerian Army's Forward Operating Base (FOB) at Kamba who mobilised and pursued some suspected bandits who stormed a farmhouse and rustled the said cows.

The statement further indicated that in an attempt to flee, the troops neutralised one of the bandits and recovered the 33 rustled cows.
