GUNMEN KILL FAMILY OF 5 IN PLATEAU

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Suspected gunmen invaded Nding community on Tuesday night in Barkin Ladi local government area of Plateau State killing six persons, including an entire family of five.

The attack, which occurred at about 9 p.m., has heightened fear among the residents.

A resident of the community, Weng Christopher, told our correspondent that the assailants stormed the area and opened fire on the unsuspecting victims.

According to him, five members of the same family were killed on the spot, while another resident was killed during the attack.

Christopher lamented the increasing frequency of such incidents, describing the situation as alarming and distressing for the residents.

Meanwhile, the publicity secretary of Berom Youth Moulders, Rwang Tengwong, has confirmed the killings and condemned the attack, calling for urgent intervention by security agencies.

In a related development gunmen also attacked herders on Tuesday in Jol community of Jol Ward of Riyom local government area, killing six cattle in the area.

The state chairman of the Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria (MACBAN)

Ibrahim Yusuf Babayo, told journalists on Wednesday in Jos that the gunmen opened fire while the herders were grazing.
