

Troops Kill Terrorists, Seize Weapons In Zamfara

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Troops of Sector 2, Joint Task Force (JTF) North West Operation FANSAN YAMMA (OPFY), have continued to record significant operational successes against terrorists and criminal elements operating within Zamfara State and other parts of North West.

A statement signed by the media officer, Joint Task Force (North West) Operation Fansan Yamma, Lt. Col. Aliyu Danja, said in the early hours of Thursday, troops of Operation Fansan Yamma, embarked on a fighting patrol to Kaura Namoda and Birnin Magaji local government areas of Zamfara State.

During the operation, troops made contact with armed terrorists at Doumbourum Village, where a fierce firefight ensued. They overwhelmed the terrorists with superior firepower, forcing them to flee in disarray after suffering significant casualties.

Following the encounter, troops successfully neutralised three terrorists and recovered a cache of arms and ammunition, including one AK-47 rifle, one machine gun, one locally fabricated handgun, 7 rifle magazines and a total of 571 rounds of ammunition. Importantly, no casualty was recorded among the troops during the operation.
