

NAF DESTROYS TERRORISTS' STRUCTURES, KILLS SCORES IN BORNO STRIKES

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The Nigerian Air Force (NAF), through the Air Component of Operation HADIN KAI, destroyed terrorists' structures and killed scores of terrorists during precision airstrikes in Borno State. A statement by the NAF Spokesman, Air Cdre Ehimen Ejodame, said the airstrikes conducted on 26 May 2026 targeted terrorist strongholds and logistics enclaves within the Sambisa Forest axis.

He said the Air Component, following credible Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance reports, deployed NAF air assets that executed precision strikes on identified terrorist hideouts and support structures at Biramiri in the Gezuwa general area of Borno State.

He said the coordinated attacks destroyed key terrorist facilities and neutralised several fighters, further crippling the operational capacity of the insurgents.

The statement noted that the ongoing air offensives have continued to generate fear and confusion among terrorist elements across the Sambisa axis.

"Intelligence assessments indicate growing apprehension and disorientation within the ranks of the terrorists as sustained bombardments deny them freedom of movement and safe havens," he said.
