

2 FEARED DEAD AS POLITICAL THUGS UNLEASH MAYHEM IN OSOGBO

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Two people were feared dead while several others sustained various degrees of injuries yesterday when suspected political thugs shot and unleashed mayhem in Osogbo, Osun State.

Commenting on the development, Governor Ademola Adeleke called on the national security adviser, the inspector-general of police, the director-general of DSS and other top security officials to beam special light on Osun State just as he appealed to President Bola Tinubu to call the minister of Marine and Blue Economy, Adegboyega Oyetola and the APC governorship candidate in the August 15 election, Bola Oyebamiji, to order.

Addressing journalists at the Government House in Osogbo after the shooting, Adeleke pointed accusing fingers at what he described as, "the destabilising roles of Marine Minister, Gboyega Oyetola and the Osun APC candidate, Bola Oyebamiji."

Adeleke claimed that the attackers in a 15 vehicle convoy branded with AMBO pictures launched attacks at Owode and proceeded to Olaiya, Old Garage, Oke Fia and even around Government House in the state capital.
