Ex-convict allegedly kills girlfriend over N100,000 in Ondo



A 37-year-old ex-convict, Omokinwa Ademola, has been arrested by the **Ondo State** Police Command for allegedly beating his girlfriend, Joy Jimoh, to death during a dispute over a N100,000 refund.

The Command's spokesperson, DSP Olayinka Ayanlade, said the tragic incident occurred on October 7 around 5:30 p.m., and was reported by one Ngozi Gregory at the Idanre Divisional Police Headquarters.

Ayanlade said preliminary investigations revealed that the suspect engaged the deceased in an argument over the repayment of money he had earlier borrowed from her.

"The quarrel reportedly escalated, leading Ademola to physically assault the victim until she lost consciousness. She was rushed to a nearby hospital for treatment but was confirmed dead by a medical practitioner," Ayanlade said.

Following the report, the Divisional Police Officer in Idanre led a team of detectives to the scene, where the suspect was apprehended.

Ayanlade added that the victim's remains had been deposited in a morgue for autopsy as investigation continues.

Commissioner of Police, (CP) Adebowale Lawal, condemned the brutal act, assuring that justice would be served.

"The Command will not tolerate any act of domestic violence or brutality under any guise," the Commissioner said.

Lawal directed that the case be transferred to the State Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department (SCIID) for a comprehensive probe.
