

Gunmen kill three FRSC officers in Kebbi

THREE Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) personnel have been killed by bandits on Tsamiya-Ilo Road in Bagudo Local Government Area of Kebbi State.

The victims were identified as DCRMA Umar Aliyu, SRMA Ezra Manu Gona and RMA I Mansur Ibrahim Nasir.

The officers were on duty, sources said, when the bandits struck. The officers tried to escape but the hoodlums pursued them with their motorcycles and killed them.

Security operatives at the Tsamiya/Maje area of Bagudo have come under several attacks by bandits and Lakurawa since last year.

Before this attack, over 10 officers of the Customs, Immigration and Police were killed by the terrorists in the Tsamiya/Maje axis of the Bagudo Local Government Area of the state from last year to date.

No statement has been issued by the FRSC Command in the state over the incident.

Governor Nasir Idris at the weekend convened an emergency security meeting at the Government House in Birnin Kebbi over the spate of bandits attacks in parts of the state.
