

Three killed in Plateau community attack



Three persons have been confirmed killed in Tarok village of Rim community of Riyom Local Government of Plateau State.

The National Publicity Secretary, Berom Youth Moulders Association (BYM), Rwang Tengwong said about 5:23 p.m. on Wednesday, some terrorists attacked the community, resulting in the killing of three innocent persons.

He said the victims had been identified as Ezekiel Zakka, David Yakubu, and Dauda Habila.

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BYM) condemned the attack and condoled with the bereaved families, Torok, and the Berom.

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He said the attack was painful and a “reminder of the worsening security situation facing Berom communities. It is deeply disturbing that innocent citizens continue to be killed while the perpetrators repeatedly evade arrest and justice”.

“We will continue to advocate relentlessly for justice for the victims, the arrest and prosecution of the attackers, and lasting peace and security across Berom land,” he added.
