

# Two killed, three others injured in Plateau community

GUNMEN have once again attacked residents of Daron village in Gyel District, Jos South Local Government Area of Plateau State, leaving two people dead.

The current attack on the community came after days of respite.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that the gunmen in their numbers attacked the village on Tuesday at about 10:00 pm when

the people were preparing to go to bed, forcing them to flee in different directions.

A source close to the village disclosed that apart from the two persons who were shot dead, three others were gunned down and sustained serious injuries, adding that the three of them are at the moment receiving treatment at the Plateau State Specialist Hospital.

A youth leader in the community who is also the president of the Berom Youths

Moulders Association, Solomon Dalyop, confirmed the killings to newsmen in Jos on Wednesday, adding that the attack was one of the many unleashed on communities in the Plateau North Senatorial District in recent times.

Dalyop said, "In another turn of events at about 10:00 pm on 21st October, 2025, bandits suspected to be armed Fulani attacked and shot dead two people, while three others sustained injuries."

He pleaded with the security agencies to redouble their efforts towards ensuring that the perpetrators of the attack and others before the latest one are brought to book, adding that non-arrest so far has continued to fuel the ugly incidents.

The spokesman of the Plateau State Police command, DSP Alfred Alabo, simply declared, "Yes, we are aware of the incident, and investigation is ongoing."
