

# Two killed, others abducted as bandits attack Kogi community

Olle community in Kabba/Bunu Local Government Area of Kogi has come under attack following an invasion by suspected bandits on Friday killing two and abducted several people along farm routes in the area.

According to report, the bandits struck residents on their way to their farms, killing at least two people during the assault. The exact number of abducted victims remains unclear as of the time of filing this report.

However, community sources confirmed that no fewer than 10 people from nearby Community Taki have already been taken by the assailants.

The bandits are also said to be currently positioned along the Olle road, raising fears of further attacks and abductions.

The incident has heightened tension in the area, with residents reportedly fleeing to safer locations and calling on security agencies to respond urgently.

Meanwhile, the Executive Chairman of Kabba/Bunu Local Government Area, Barrister Dare Michael, confirmed the incident through a press statement issued by his Chief Press Secretary, John Omofa, and

made available on his social media handle.

He assured residents that the government and security agencies are on top of the situation, with the rescue of the victims underway.

He said the government will not fold its hands and allow the bandits to continue to have free rein.

He commiserated with the families and communities who lost loved ones in the incident, prayed for their repose.

He pointed out that those behind the dastardly act will be apprehended.
