

# Kano NSCDC sets up committee to investigate volunteer's death

The **Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC)**, Kano State Command, has set up a committee of inquiry to investigate the circumstances surrounding the **death of Halifa Abdullahi**, a volunteer attached to the Fagge Divisional Office.

This was disclosed in a statement issued by the Command's Public Relations Officer, SC Ibrahim Idris Abdullahi, a copy made available to the press in Kano.

According to the statement, the State Commandant, Commandant Mohammed Hassan Agalama, ordered a discreet and impartial investigation into the unfortunate incident to ensure justice for the deceased and his family.

The Command assured the public that no individual found culpable would be spared, stressing that justice would be served without fear or favour.

"The NSCDC, Kano State Command, is assuring the family, relatives, friends and associates of the deceased, as well as the general public, that justice will be served. Any erring staff found wanting will face the full weight of the law. There is no sacred cow, as all are equal before the law," the statement read.

The Command further disclosed that the Nigerian Police are heavily involved in the investigation to guarantee transparency and fairness in the process.

Commandant Agalama, on behalf of the NSCDC, expressed deep sympathy and heartfelt condolences to the family and relatives of the deceased, praying for the repose of his soul.

He also appealed to members of the public to remain calm, law-abiding and peaceful, urging them to allow due process and the full dispensation of justice in the matter.
