

One dead, multiple injured in Lagos-Ibadan Expressway crash

A yet-to-be-identified middle-aged woman has lost her life, while others sustained varying degrees of injuries, in a road accident that occurred at the Iwo Road end of the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway on Tuesday.

The accident, which involved four vehicles, has been attributed to brake failure.

The affected vehicles, as disclosed in reports by the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), include a red MICRA car with registration number MNY 539 XN, a white tanker truck, and a commercial Toyota HIACE bus with registration number BBS 863XA.

The driver of one of the vehicles reportedly lost control, resulting in multiple collisions.

One of the victims, a woman, died on the spot, while others with varying degrees of injuries are receiving medical attention at a nearby hospital.

The accident has been confirmed by the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), Oyo State.
