

Troops kill two insurgents in Bomo ambush

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TROOPS of the Operation HADIN KAI have killed two suspected terrorists during a night ambush operation in Konduga Local Government Area of Borno State.

Sources said that the operation was conducted at about 11:05 p.m. on May 13, at Bazamri village, an area identified as a major crossing route for ISWAP members.

It was learnt that troops, acting on intelligence, laid ambush at the location and intercepted the insurgents while attempting to move through the area.

According to the sources, the troops engaged the suspects in a gun battle, resulting in the killing of two insurgents, while others fled.

Following the encounter, troops searched the area and recovered items suspected to be logistics supplies for the terrorists.

Items recovered included 54 packs of 80 gram detergent, 32 packs of 500 gram salt and one carton of spaghetti.

Military authorities confirmed that no casualty was recorded among the troops during the operation.
