

32 killed in Kwara, Ogun, Kogi road crashes

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•FRSC blames driver fatigue, dangerous driving

IN Ilorin, Kwara State capital, a total of 15 persons, all males, reportedly lost their lives in an auto crash at the Muslim cemetery, along Ogbomosho-Oko Olowo route on Ilorin-Jebba expressway.

A Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) report reports that the lone accident, which occurred at about 2:32 am on Monday, involved a trailer vehicle DAF XF with registration number: GWL274XC, which was carrying a total of 48 people (all males).

Seventeen people sustained varying degrees of injury.

It attributed the cause of the accident to fatigue on the part of the driver, adding that the types of injury sustained include fracture, dislocation and bruises.

The auto crash was confirmed by the FRSC Sector Commander, Kabiru Babatunde Kazeem.

Kazeem said the injured victims had been taken to Arewa Medical Centre and Baki Hospital for medical attention, while the corpses had been handed over to the representative of the families and the Sarkin Hausawa, Oko Olowo in the Moro Local Government Area of Kwara State.
