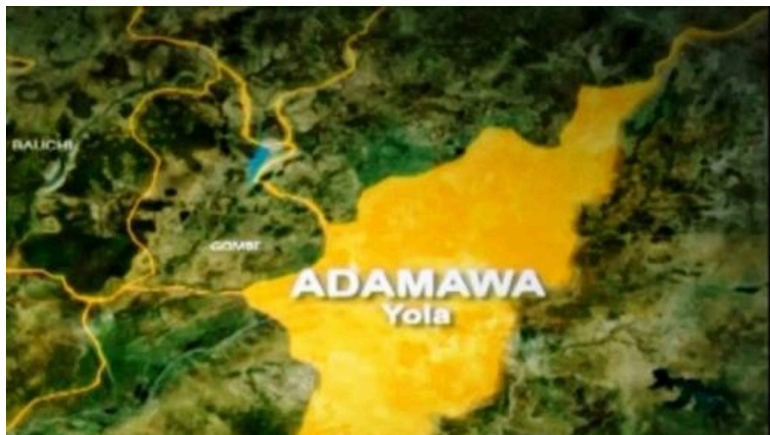


Lady found dead with stab wounds in Adamawa

A yet-to-be-identified young woman was discovered dead with stab wounds behind the fence of a university located in the Mubi Local Government Area of Adamawa State.

PUNCH Metro learnt on Thursday that residents of the community discovered the corpse on Tuesday and promptly alerted the police.

A counter-insurgency expert, Zagazola Makama, who shared details of the incident on X (formerly Twitter), disclosed that the residents had alerted the police, prompting a team to visit the scene.

According to him, the Divisional Police Officer led a team to the location and recovered the body before depositing it at a mortuary.

Makama wrote, “A distress call was received by the Divisional Police Officer of Mubi North at about 12:00 p.m. on October 21, reporting that an unidentified female corpse was found behind the Adamawa State University fence with multiple stab wounds.

“On receipt of the report, the DPO led a team of detectives to the scene, took photographs, and evacuated the corpse to the Federal Medical Centre, Mubi, for autopsy,” the source was quoted as saying.

He noted that further police investigation led to the arrest of two suspects in connection with the incident.

“According to the source, preliminary investigation led to the arrest of one Private Tanko Salihu and one Yahaya Idi Gadzama.”

When contacted for comment, the spokesperson for the Adamawa State Police Command, Yahaya Suleiman, stated that he had yet to be briefed about the incident but promised to get back to our correspondent.

However, repeated calls made to his mobile line on Thursday were unanswered at the time of filing this report.

This is not the first time ladies have been victims of stab attacks that often resulted in death, even beyond the shores of Nigeria.

PUNCH Metro reported on August 6 that a 60-year-old Nigerian, Nkiru Chima, was found dead with multiple stab wounds in her apartment located in Romford, United Kingdom.

Another PUNCH Metro report in March indicated that tragedy struck in the Agbure community, Ogun Waterside Local Government Area of Ogun State, when a man identified simply as Oju reportedly stabbed his 36-year-old wife, Josephine Isaac, to death during a violent altercation.

These incidents showed a broader pattern of domestic violence and vulnerability of females during such attacks.
