

Suspected B'Haram Terrorists Kill 30 In Adamawa Attack



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...Fintiri visits scene

No fewer than 30 persons have reportedly been killed in Guyaku Community in Tela Bala of Gombi Local Government Area of Adamawa State, following attack by suspected Boko Haram on Sunday evening.

This was made known by Governor Ahmadu Fintiri when he paid an official visit to the scene yesterday, as he reiterated his resolve to work with security agencies to prevent a recurrence and restore normalcy to the area.



Governor Fintiri used the opportunity to condole with the bereaved families and assured residents of government's commitment to improving security.

Our Correspondent reports that the atmosphere in the community remains tense, with grief and fear evident among residents, particularly women, children, and the elderly, many of whom have abandoned their homes over concerns of further attacks.

The incident, which also left many injured, resulted in the destruction of homes and properties and has plunged the area into mourning and heightened concern across the state.

Community leader, Kumo Gombi, Aggrey Ali said the attackers operated for several hours, killing dozens of residents, burning places of worship, and destroying property including motorcycles.

Reacting to the development, Senator Aishatu Dahiru Ahmed Binani, conveyed her deepest condolences and heartfelt sympathy to the people of Gombi Local Government Area and the entire Adamawa State.

In a statement, Senator Binani described the attack as a grievous and heartbreaking occurrence, noting that the pain is shared not only by the immediate victims but by all citizens of the state. She stated that; "This is a profoundly distressing moment for our people.

I extend my heartfelt condolences to the families who have lost their loved ones and pray for comfort for all those affected." Binani prayed for the repose of the souls of the deceased, asking Almighty Allah to forgive their shortcomings and grant them Aljannatul Firdaus and further prayed for the speedy and full recovery of those injured in the attack.
