

Gunmen Kill Petroleum Varsity Lecturer In Delta



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Suspected gunmen have killed a lecturer of the Federal University of Petroleum Resources (FUPRE) at Effurun, Mr Emmanuel Meeting, in Delta State.

The victim was murdered under an unknown circumstance at his residence in Ugbomro Community around mid night. His brother said the victim made frantic effort to reach out to him on phone when his assailants wanted to kill him but to no avail.

He said: "When I got his call at midnight, I swiftly rushed to the scene, only to discover that my brother has been killed." The killing has sparked panic, grief and concern within the community.



A Senior Lecturer of the University (names withheld) in Asaba yesterday said the academic community in FUPRE was thrown into turmoil. He said the lecturers have called for a full scale investigation to unravel the mystery behind the killing.
