

LASU Student Dies In Off Campus Armed Robbery Attack



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The Lagos State University (LASU) community is in mourning after a final-year student of the institution died from injuries sustained during an armed robbery attack in the Iba area of the state, the university announced yesterday.

The student, Otabor Boluwatife Joseph, of the Department of History and International Studies, Faculty of Arts, was attacked alongside friends on the night of May 29, in an off-campus incident that has once again raised concerns about security in areas surrounding the university.

The 24-year-old died on Tuesday, June 2, after fighting for his life in hospital. In a statement by the Acting Coordinator of the Centre for Information and Public Relations, Mr. Olaniyi Jeariogbe, the university expressed profound grief over the loss.
