

Deadly Rainstorm Kills Grandmother, Granddaughter In Bauchi

A devastating rainstorm has claimed the lives of a 50-year-old woman and her four-year-old granddaughter in Kirfi Local Government Area of [Bauchi State](#).

The victims, identified as Aisha Sagir and Aisha Shuaibu, both residents of Unguwar Katsinawa in Bara Village, reportedly died when heavy rainfall accompanied by strong winds swept through the area on Wednesday.

According to the [Bauchi State Police Command](#), the incident occurred at about 10 a.m., causing widespread destruction in the community.



Police spokesperson, SP Nafiu Habib, said preliminary reports indicated that several houses were damaged, while livestock and other valuables worth millions of naira were destroyed.

He said officers attached to the Kirfi Divisional Police Headquarters had visited the affected area to assess the damage and maintain law and order.

Reacting to the tragedy, the Commissioner of Police, CP Sani-Omolori Aliyu, expressed condolences to the bereaved family and residents of the local government area.

The police chief prayed for the repose of the deceased and urged residents to remain vigilant throughout the rainy season and promptly report emergencies to security agencies.
