

One Dead, Others Missing In Another Rivers Building Collapse



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...two rescued, search for others continues

A construction worker has been declared dead and some others are rescued after a four-storey under-construction [building collapsed](#) along Dr Peter Odili Road, close to Eterna Filling Station in Port-Harcourt, Rivers State.

The incident happened [barely 24 hours after a three-storey building under construction collapsed in Iwofe, in Obio/Akpor Local Government](#) Area days after workers heard cracking sounds and voluntarily evacuated the site.

The trapped workers, whose number is unconfirmed in the latest incident, were said to have resumed work on Wednesday morning and were just starting their work when the incident happened.

Unlike the building collapse that occurred earlier in Iwofe, where there was no casualty, rescue efforts have intensified to bring out the trapped workers from the rubble of the building.

Already, two workers have been rescued from the rubble by emergency workers and taken to the hospital, a development that has raised the hope of some among the crowd watching the rescue efforts.

One of the rescue officials said that one of the rescued workers said there were more workers in the rubble, explaining that they were together when the building collapsed.

Rescue efforts were still ongoing at the time of this report.
