

Communal Clash Claims 10 Lives, Leaves Several Houses Burnt In Niger

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No fewer than ten villagers have been killed and many houses burnt in a communal clash between the [Fulani](#) and Kamuku dwellers in Mararaban Gwadar and Tashan Bako, both in Rafi Local Government Area of [Niger State](#).

[New Telegraph](#) gathered that the incident, which occurred on Tuesday, was an aftermath of a clash that ensued between the same groups some weeks ago, in which a life was claimed.

Confirming the attacks, Chairman of Rafi [Local Government Area](#), Ayuba Usman Katako, said investigations have commenced to unravel those responsible.

Katako maintained that no responsible government will fold its arms and allow its people to be killed, adding that security agencies have been drafted to the area.

Findings have it that the worst hit in the reprisal attack are women and children who were harmless.

As at the time of filing this report, no statement on the attacks has been issued as the Police Public Relations Officer, SP Wasiu Abiodun, could not be reached.
