

Suspected herdsmen invade Delta communities, kill woman, injure man

SUSPECTED Fulani herdsmen have invaded Okpara Waterside and Kokoni communities of Ethiope East Local Government Area of Delta State macheting a middle aged woman to death and another sustaining injuries while escaping from their hands.

The middle aged woman who was identified as Mrs. Helen was killed at the early hours of Wednesday after attempting to

rape her, while the man identified as Mr. Edafe escaped death with severe injuries.

It was reliably gathered that the incident has brought serious threats and fear into the neighbouring communities of Okpara Inland, Ovu Inland, Eku, Orhoakpo for the fear of the unknown since the invasion of both communities.

According to a source who spoke on the ground of

anonymity, the late Mrs Helen had gone out at the early hours of Wednesday in search of cherry when the suspected herders hatched her to death after the allegedly harassing her.

Meanwhile, Mr. Edafe according to a source, was matcheted on the head and other parts of his body before he narrowly escaped with degrees of injuries and that he is presently receiving treatment in an
