

2 killed, 2 injured in fresh terror attack on Plateau community

JOS—TWO persons were killed and two others injured when suspected terrorists attacked Gassa community in Bar-kin Ladi Local Government Area of Plateau State on Saturday night.

It was gathered that the attackers stormed the community around 11 p.m., shooting sporadically and causing panic among residents.

A resident, Albert Bature, who confirmed the incident, said the attack had thrown the community into mourning.

"The gunmen invaded the community at about 11 p.m. on Saturday and start-

ed shooting at everything in sight. Two persons were killed while two others sustained injuries. This incident has left our people in grief and fear," he said.

Also confirming the attack, the National Publicity Secretary of the Berom Youth Moulders Association, Rwang Tengwong, condemned the incident and expressed concern over the recurring violence in the area.

He called on security agencies to intensify efforts to protect lives and property in Gassa and neighbouring communities.

As of the time of filing this report, the spokesman of the Plateau State Police Command, Alfred Alabo, could not be reached for official confirmation.
