Suspected madman stabs man to death in Warri

camera, said the victim lost a large amount of blood and died before reaching the hospital where he was rushed to.

One eyewitness said: "It was in the evening yesterday (Wednesday) when the madman, a familiar face in the area, stabbed a man in our market with a knife and he died.

Some people said they had seen him walking around with a knife.

"Those who rushed the victim to the hospital later came back and announced that he did not survive. You could feel the anger. I heard some youths went in search of him, found him where he was sitting, and lynched him."

WARRI—A suspected mentally unstable man, Wednesday evening, allegedly stabbed a man to death at the popular Sapele Market, in Warri South Local Government Area of Delta State.

Eyewitnesses said an angry mob immediately mobilised and set the suspect ablaze after confirming that the victim had died.

It was gathered that the suspect had earlier snatched fish from a vendor's tray and the deceased attempted to caution him. He was said to have suddenly pulled out a knife and stabbed the man.

Kano rescues 19-month-old child from alleged abuse

KANO—THE Kano State Ministry of Women Affairs, Children and Persons with Special Needs, has rescued a 19-month-old child from alleged abuse and neglect, in Gezawa Local Government Area of the state.

This was contained in a statement issued yesterday in Kano by the Director of Public Enlightenment in the ministry, Bintu Nuhu-Yamasaki.

The victim, a male toddler, was rescued following reports by residents of Tsamiya Babba community over alleged maltreatment by his foster mother.

According to the statement, the Commissioner for Women Affairs, Children and Persons with Special Needs, Hajiya Amina Abdullahi, acted swiftly after receiving verified reports.
