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Headless body of woman sparks panic in Ondo GRA

AKURE —Anxiety has gripped residents of the Government Reservation Area, GRA Roundabout in Ondo, Ondo State, following the discovery of the mutilated and headless body of an unidentified woman.

Vanguard gathered that several parts of the victim's body had been mutilated by her assailants.

A police source said the body was discovered by residents in the area about 9:40a.m. The incident was subsequently reported at the

police station.

Acting on the report, a team of police operatives was immediately deployed to the scene.

Confirming the incident, the state police command spokesperson, Jimoh Abayomi, said: "Preliminary observations revealed that several parts of the body had been mutilated."

According to him, "Investigations have commenced to determine the circumstances surrounding the incident, identity of the deceased, apprehend those responsible and establish the

motive behind the gruesome act."

He condemned the barbaric act and assured the public that no effort would be spared in bringing the perpetrators to justice.

The police spokesperson also urged "members of the public who may have useful information that could assist the investigation to report to the nearest police station or contact the Command through its emergency lines.

"The area remains calm and adequate security measures have been put in place to ensure the safety of residents while investigations continue."
