Umuahia – THE bitter rivalry between Governor Theodore Orji of Abia State and PDP on one side and his former political mentor and ex-governor of the state, Chief Orji Kalu and his party, Progressive Peoples Alliance, PPA, on the other, came to a head Tuesday as a clash between their supporters at Ohafia left at least two persons dead.

Many others were said to have sustained serious injuries and are being treated in hospitals in the area. Though Abia State Police Command headquarters in Umuahia said it had got report of the incident, the DPO at Ohafia did not confirm or deny the incident.

He only said he would not give information to somebody he didn't know when contacted on phone. The incident occurred when the governor went to Ohafia to canvass for votes.

According to eyewitness, hardly had the rally ended than the party supporters who had converged on the venue, accosted one of the officials of government for settlement.

"The security men may have misconstrued the surge as violence against the governor and opened fire on the people killing one man on the spot, while several others were injured," the eyewitness said.


The man, who died on the spot, was identified as a resident of Amaekpu in Ohafia local government area and had gone there to support the governor.


