

Gunmen kill policeman's daughter of 6

GUNMEN Sunday raided the house of a police sergeant located at Dandali ward of Potiskum Local Government Area of Yobe State, killed his six years old daughter and injured two of his sons.

A resident told *Daily Trust* that the gunmen stormed the residence of the police sergeant, Hassan Isah, at around 9:00pm and opened fire on him while sitting with his family.

“He narrowly escaped the gunshots, but his six-year-old daughter, Safiya Hassan, was killed by stray bullets that wounded two of his sons. This is the second time he is escaping this kind of attack, the last time was before he relocated to his personal house week ago,” a source said.

The Police Public Relations Officer, Mr Gbagesin Toyin , confirmed the attack, saying that “It was in the process of the attack that a seven-old daughter was killed,” he said.

FRSC recovers N9m at crash scene

NINE million belonging to a deceased accident victim was recovered at the scene of road crash along the Lokoja- Koton Karfe road in Kogi State by the rescue team of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC). The money was returned to the deceased family.
