25 March 2014	Maiduguri, Borno	Three civilians died when a car bomb exploded in the Government Farm area. <sup>3</sup>
14 April 2014	Abuja, FCT	A car bomb at Nyanya bus station, on the outskirts of Abuja, killed more than 70 people. <sup>4</sup>
1 May 2014	Abuja, FCT	At least 12 people died in a second car bomb attack on the Nyanya motor park. <sup>5</sup>
12 May 2014	Gwaram LGA, Jigawa	A roadside bomb killed three soldiers travelling in a convoy. <sup>6</sup>
18 May 2014	Kano, Kano	A suicide bomber killed four civilians in the Sabon Gari area of Kano. <sup>7</sup>
20 May 2014	Jos, Plateau	Two explosions killed more than 100 people. Car bombs detonated outside a market and a hospital.8
1 June 2014	Mubi, Adamawa	More than 10 people died when a bomb detonated near a shop.9
17 June 2014	Damaturu, Yobe	21 people died when a bomb exploded at a venue screening the World Cup. <sup>10</sup>
23 June 2014	Kano, Kano	A bomb at the School of Hygiene killed eight people. <sup>11</sup>
23 June 2014	Gwoza, Borno	A car bomb killed three soldiers at a checkpoint. <sup>12</sup>
25 June 2014	Abuja, FCT	22 people died when a bomb exploded at the Banex plaza shopping centre. 13
25 June 2014	Lagos, Lagos	Boko Haram claimed responsibility for explosions near the Apapa fuel depot, which killed two people. Authorities stated that the explosion was an accident. <sup>14</sup>
27 June 2014	Bauchi, Bauchi	In Bauchi a bomb killed 10 people. <sup>15</sup>
1 July 2014	Maiduguri, Borno	An explosion at the Monday Market killed at least 20 people. <sup>16</sup>
4 July 2014	Konduga, Borno	(A car bomb killed five people at a checkpoint. <sup>17)</sup>
23 July 2014	Kaduna, Kaduna	Two bombs killed around 40 people close to a square where a prominent Islamic cler was speaking to a crowd. The cleric is a critic of Boko Haram. 18
27 July 2014	Kano, Kano	Five civilians and one soldier died when a bomb was thrown at people leaving churcl A female suicide bomber detonated explosives near the university. No-one else died i the explosion. <sup>19</sup>
29 July 2014	Potiskum, Yobe	19 people died when a suicide bomber targeted civilians at a market and men threw improvised explosive devices from a car at a mosque. <sup>20</sup>
31 July 2014	Kano, Kano	Two people died when a suicide bomber, alleged to be a child, detonated her explosives outside Kano State Polytechnic. <sup>21</sup>
22 October 2014	Azare, Bauchi	Five people died when a bomb exploded at a motor park. <sup>22</sup>
7 November 2014	Azare, Bauchi	A bomb outside a bank killed 14 people. <sup>23</sup>
10 November 2014	Potiskum, Yobe	49 students died when a suicide bomber attacked the Senior Science Secondary School. <sup>24</sup>
12 November 2014	Kontagora, Niger	A suicide bomber attacked the Federal College of Education. No-one else was killed. <sup>2</sup>
14 November 2014	Kano, Kano	A car bomb killed the driver and five other people at the Magarshiku Filling Station o the outskirts of Kano. <sup>26</sup>
