In Muharram 1438 AH, the followers of Shekau carried out an attack on the Karino area south of Lake Chad, led also by Muhammad Bakr, and an army composed of 350 men, and they seized the village of Tunubuma and seized some of the vehicles of the soldiers of the Caliphate. Then the soldiers of the Caliphate repelled them in a counter-attack and clashed with them with different types of weapons, resulting in the killing of more than 75, including the leader Muhammad Bakr.
