

Suspect admits killing of former Anambra commissioner

The killer of the Anambra state former commissioner for women affairs, Uzor Obi Okoli has owned up to the dastardly act.

The woman's second son, Chuka Okoli has confessed to the Anambra state police command that he killed his mother for personal reasons.

The boy, who was brought back from Lagos to Awka, Anambra state Wednesday at about 8 pm told the Anambra state police command the reason for his action and gave other useful information.

Despite being economical with word on the confession, the state acting police commissioner, Haruna John however told reporters that investigation on the matter was still on going.

"One Chuka Okoli believed to be the second son of the de-

ceased ex-commissioner was arrested in Lagos two days ago and brought down last night here, he has been interrogated."

"Actually, he made a confessional statement giving details of what he did that day and up to the time he came and shot and killed his mother, as for what might have transpired between him and his mother or other family members before that unfortunate episode we cannot say for certain, parental care from his own perspective might be different from what we understand"

However, according to police sources, the boy disclosed that since his childhood, he had lacked that parental care a child supposed to have received from parents, adding that he was abandoned to his own faith at the age of three by his parents.

Again, it was gathered that the boy, was not insane as being speculated, rather that he was once an ex-convict, who was jailed in Atlanta United States of America for four years which expired last year before he was deported to Nigeria in 2005.

It was also revealed that the tinted 500 Sel Mercedes benz car he drove along with him after the incident was abandoned at auchi street in Edo state in a mechanic workshop.

According to further investigation, the 27 year old Chuka, the second in a family of seven, it was discovered was over pampered by the parents to the extend that he failed to finish his secondary education in Nigeria before he was ferried abroad which also did not materialize before he was jailed for robbery.
