An eyewitness said the robbery suspects were riding in a jeep when they suspected that an army pat vehicle following them might be on their trail.

The witness said that while the robbers were trying to avoid the army patrol team, their jeep hit a vehicle a they began to shoot at the unsuspecting patrol team.
