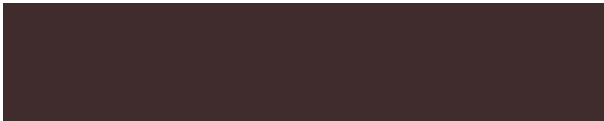

3 killed, 20 injured in Anambra gunfight

Three persons were killed and 20 others injured in a gun duel between soldiers and a gang of robbers in Nnobi community in Idemili South Local Government Area of Anambra on Monday.

The battle, which occurred by 12: 30p.m. at the busy Nnobi Junction, left two soldiers seriously wounded and two members of the gang dead, witnesses said.

Among the dead in the fight, which caused a pandemonium in the usually quiet community was a passerby. witnesses said.



An eyewitness said the robbery suspects were riding in a jeep when they suspected that an army patrol vehicle following them might be on their trail.

The witness said that while the robbers were trying to avoid the army patrol team, their jeep hit a vehicle and they began to shoot at the unsuspecting patrol team.

“In the process, the soldiers replied fire for fire resulting in two of the soldiers sustaining critical injuries, while two of the robbers were shot dead instantly.

“The soldiers sustained bullet wounds, while the rest of the robbers escaped,” the witness said. Eme Chukwuemeka, Anambra Police Command Public Relations Officer, confirmed the incident.

Chukwuemeka said security men were on the trail of the others, who escaped, adding, “I am still waiting for further details and new development on the incident.” (NAN)
