Boko Haram kills policeman, robs bank

uthorities say members of a radical Muslim sect, Boko Haram, attacked a bank in Damboa near Maiduguri, killing one policeman and stealing an undisclosed sum of money.

Borno State police com-

missioner, Simeone Midenda, said the attack happened Wednesday in Damboa, a city about 55 miles (90 kilome-

ters) south of the state capital, Maiduguri. Midenda said sect members used motorcycles

in the attack, which also left three people injured.

The sect has carried out a string of assassinations and bombings in within the north and Abuja in its campaign to implement strict Shariah law in parts of the country.

The sect claimed responsi-

The sect claimed responsibility for the August 26 suicide car bombing at the United Nations headquarters in Abuja that killed 23 people and wounded 116 others.
