Succour has come the way of families of the 23 persons that were recently killed by unknown gunmen at Kabaro village in Maru local government council, Zamfara state, as the council donated 100 bags of rice and N500,000 cash to the deceased families.

The Chairman, Alhaji Lawali Aliyu Dangulbi, who presented the items to the village head of Kabaro, Alhaji Muhammad Kabaro, at the weekend, in Kabaro, said he was shocked when he received the news about the attack while in Saudi Arabia for this year's hajj

exercise.

Dangulbi, while condoling with the people of the area, called on the people of the state to assist the council with special prayers for God's protection due to the persistent attacks being carried out by gunmen in the area.

He said arrangements had reached top level for the provision of GSM network services at Dangulbi by MTN network services provider in order to ease communication with people of the community whenever there was any security threat in the area.

Dangulbi assured the people that "as soon as the state government completes its N15 billion road contract linking Magami-Dangulbi-Dankirmi-Anka, security personnel will find it easy to come to the area for emergency interventions."

Responding, the district head of Kabaro thanked the chairman for his concern and assistance to families of the deceased.
