Robbers attack another Lagos bank



Three feared killed

RMED robbers again struck at a commercial bank around Lekki phase one area in Lagos yesterday, killing three and stealing undisclosed amount of money.

It was the fifth operation in Lagos area within three weeks.

However, police spokesman, Olubode Ojajimi, a Deputy Superintendent (DSP), denied that anybody was killed.

He said that no money was removed form the bank as policemen arrived at the scene less than five minutes after he robbers came.

The Comet gathered that the bandits numbering over 30, came through the creeks with two speed boats around 10.30 a.m, when banking was in full swing.

The heavily armed men shot their way into the hall, ordered all the customers as well as staff to lie face down while they ransacked the entire hall.

Though, it was not confirmed whether the robbers gained access to the bank's vault, all other monies with both the paying and receiving cashiers as well as those with customers were stolen.

The robbers after the successful operation escaped with their loot through the same waterways.
