Tragedy struck at Mosafejo road

Amukoko, Lagos recently as two brothers fell into a deep well and drowned in it.

Messers 'Ahmed Akanbi and Isah Akanbi were said to have fallen into an uncovered well,

dug in front of their house while attempting to repair the well.

Daily Champion learnt that the two brothers were immediately rescued by some residents of the compound and quickly taken to a nearby hospital where they gave up the ghost.

Our correspondent

learnt that tragedy occurred when the duo attempted to effect minor repairs on the toilet, not knowing that the slab (cover) of the toilet was weak and feeble. Both of them fell into the well, said to be over 20 metres deep.

An eyewitness told

our correspondent that the incident occurred at about 2pm on June 28, 2006.

She said that Ahmed was the elder brother of Isah, noting that both lived a peaceful life.

Confirming the

incident, Police Public relations Officer (PPRO), Mr. Olubode Ojajuni said the duo of Ahmed and Isah Akanbi fell into a well and drowned, they were rescued and rushed to hospital where they died."

Ojajuni, a deputy superintendent of Police (DSP) said the corpses were deposited in a public morgue for autopsy.
