Robbery: Police kill 2 suspects in

TWO alleged armed I robbers, who specialise in robbing houses in Port Harcourt, the capital of Rivers State using Motorcycles, have been shot by the police.

The robbers whose names where not given by the Police were said to have been terrorising residence of Trans-

o partner **ICAN**

13-16, 2006.

According to him, their request for sponsorship for the Bayelsa delegation to attend the annual Accountants Conference coming up from

Amadi Industrial Layout.

They allegedly operate on a red Motorcycle with

registration number QL485 PĤC.

They were shot in a shoot out with the Police at a swamp in an attempt to escape after robbing a victim of his belongings.

Although Police said alleged robbers were gunned down with injuries, it said they later died while being taken to a hospital for treatment.

The incident which happened last Monday, has however, reduced robbers criminal activities along the area.

The police command said items such as fabricated

Port Harcourt pistols, charms, one Kymco Motorcycle and live cartridges were recovered

from the alleged robbers. When contacted, Commissioner of Police, Rivers State, Mr. Samuel Adetuyi, while confirming the killing said, the robbers were noted for their notorious

activities in the area. Adetuyi appeal for the residence of the state to always report crimes to the Police for possible arrest and prosecution of suspects adding, the act of society policing belongs to all asundry.

According to him, the command is combatant ready to sanitise the state free from crimes and criminalities.
